Purpose

The purpose of the CLEP tests is to provide an opportunity for students and prospective students to earn college credit through the College Level Examination Program. General Policies

- A. Applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
- B. A maximum of 30 semester hours of credit may be earned through this examination process. The 30 hour maximum also includes all other non-traditional credit.
- C. Scores must be submitted directly to MAC from the College Board.
- D. A minimum score of 50 is required for credit to be granted.
- E. The grade will be designated as ‘CR’ for credit and the number of credit hours awarded will be designated on the student’s permanent record as accepted from the CLEP Exam.
- F. There is no assurance that credit awarded for CLEP by Mineral Area College will be accepted by another institution of higher learning in transfer.
