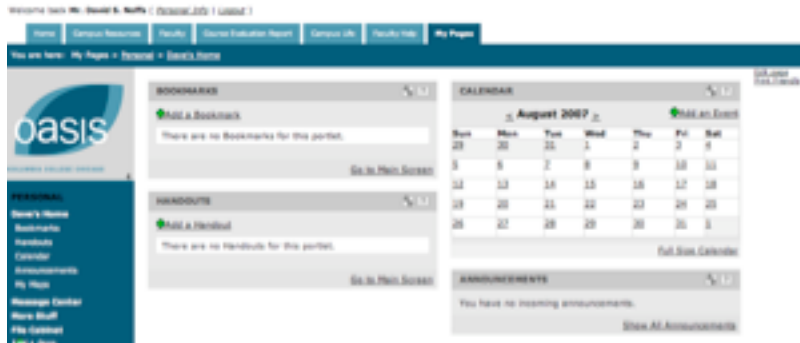


Embedding YouTube Videos in your class pages



Navigate to the YouTube website at www.youtube.com and select the YouTube video you wish to use on your page. In this example, I will be using a short clip entitled, Dramatic Chipmunk. Once you have located the video clip you wish to use, look for the embed html code located in a field to the right of the video, entitled Embed. Highlight ALL the code inside this box.


Embedding YouTube Videos (continued)



Choose Edit> Command C on a Mac or Control C on a PC to copy the code into the clipboard (temporary memory). In this example I am going to embed the video in my Home Page under the My Pages tab. Click on the Edit Page link in the top right hand side of the page. Click on the Content Tab and click on the Add Custom Content link to create a new Custom Content portlet.

Embedding YouTube Videos (continued)


Type in the name of the new custom content portlet you wish to add. In this example, I am simply calling it Dramatic Chipmunk. Click create. Click Save and Exit to return to your home page or, if you wish to reposition the portlet, use the Layout Tab to do so. You will now see an empty Custom Content portlet on your page entitled Dramatic Chipmunk. Click on Create Content.

For embedding YouTube, Flash or Streaming Video content, YOU MUST SWITCH TO HTML mode in the text box area. In the Custom Content portlet set up window, simply check the box that says Display the following text within this element, position the cursor in the text box area and use the Edit> Paste command to paste the Embed Code into the text box area.
