

Emergency Medical Technician – Basic Certificate

This sixteen week course provides the basic instruction for persons responsible for the delivery of emergency medical services. The eight credit hour course meets three evenings per week. In addition to the 110 hours of classroom instruction, four twelve hour emergency department rotations and three twelve hour ambulance rotations are required. Successful completion of a practical exam and a written exam will allow the student to be enrolled in the national registry of EMT's and apply for a Missouri State EMT license.

Emergency Medical Technician – Basic

Prerequisite: A score of 60 or above on the Reading section of the COMPASS test or successful completion of an English Comp I course. The student must be age eighteen (18) before taking state examinations at the completion of the course.
