GENERAL POLICIES

1. An application for graduation must be filed during the first 2 weeks after the fall and spring semester begins and during the first week of the summer term. Applications received after that date will be held until the following semester.
2. Students must attend commencement exercises to receive a diploma.
3. Graduates are required to undergo outcome tests as a condition of graduation.
4. Graduates are required to complete an exit interview with the Director of Career Services.
5. Cumulative 2.0 grade point average required for graduation.
6. Last fifteen (15) hours must be earned at Mineral Area College.
