## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR AAT DEGREE

### A student wishing to graduate with the AAT degree...

1. ...must complete sixty (60) semester hours minimum PLUS two (2) hours of PE activity classes. School Health may be taken as a substitute only with a physician's excuse.
2. ...must complete the application for graduation must be filed with the registrar first two weeks after the fall and spring semester begins and during the first week of the summer eight (8) week term. Applications received after that date will be held until the following semester.
3. ...must schedule and take the college's exit exam. A student who has earned a previous Associate's degree may petition Arts & Sciences Dean for a waiver from taking this exam a second time. Students who do not take the exit exam or who do not have a waiver will not graduate.
4. ...must earn the last fifteen (15) hours must be earned at Mineral Area College. Students wishing to transfer any hours from any college to fulfill this requirement must petition the Registrar for a Home Rule Waiver which must be approved by his/her Dean.
5. ...must complete all program applications, complete 15 credit hours with a 2.5 GPA or better, undergo a background screening, and have a clear record prior to being admitted to the program and participating in field experience. (See detailed background check policy.)
6. ...must complete the Missouri Educator Profile (MEP).
7. ...must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher beginning fall 2013 with no grade less than a "B" in all education coursework and content area and no grade less than a "C" in all other courses.
8. ...must complete electives 1000 level or above will be accepted from both the Arts & Sciences and Career & Technical Divisions.
9. ...may take no more than six (6) elective credits by participating in ensembles (see catalog for course listings). Ensembles do not satisfy the humanities requirements.
10. ...must pass mandatory state proficiency exam; must be passed in order to receive passing grade in Portfolio and have the AAT conferred.
11. ... must complete a Portfolio with a grade of "B" or above in Foliotek.
