ART SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Mineral Area College Art Department offers art scholarships each year to students interested in majoring in art. The scholarship may be applied to the cost of Mineral Area College tuition/fees/required textbooks and/or on-campus housing costs at College Park.

The student must enroll in at least one studio art class per semester, take part in the student art club, and participate in art department sponsored art shows.

The scholarships are awarded for one semester, but are renewable for three more semesters if: (a) academic progress is acceptable; and (b) the student fulfills his or her art department obligations.

Students are selected for the scholarship on the basis of a portfolio of their work and a personal interview. The portfolio should contain 15 to 20 examples of their work with an emphasis placed on drawing. Portfolios may be in the form of slides or original art work.

Following receipt of the completed scholarship application, students will be notified when portfolios are to be turned in and scheduled for an interview with a member of the art department faculty.
