Students who maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress are allowed to receive aid until the maximum credit limit is reached, or the requirements for the current degree are reached. Students are not allowed to receive aid if they have attempted more than 150% of the credits required to complete a specific program. For example, a student seeking a degree requiring 62 credit hours may attempt a total of 93 credit hours. This is referred to as the “Maximum Time-Frame Policy.”

If a student has attempted more than 150% of the credits required for degree completion, they may submit an appeal that will explain why they have accumulated the excessive hours, their current degree plans and the time-frame they expect to complete it. If the “Maximum Time-Frame Appeal” is approved, a student may only receive financial aid for the courses remaining to complete the declared degree program. Please type or print legibly.
