SUBJECT: Spring 2010 EXCEL/SSS Scholarship

I am happy to announce the EXCEL/SSS Scholarship competition for the Spring 2010 semester. One (1) institutional scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded to an EXCEL/SSS Student for the current semester. This is a competitive scholarship, so please read and follow the directions below carefully.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Returning student with a *minimum of 24 credit hours but no more than 60 credit hours*;
- Minimum *cumulative grade point average of 2.5*;
- Enrolled *full-time*;
- Completion of the FAFSA Form is required; priority will be given to students with highest unmet need;
- Student may not be on financial aid probation or suspension;
- Student must be working toward an AA, AGS, AS, or AAS Degree. *Students working toward a Certificate are not eligible*;
- Student must have a *minimum of 12 in-person contacts with EXCEL/SSS in the two semesters preceding award of the scholarship*. In addition, applicants *must have a current (i.e., Spring 2010) Student Action Plan (SAP)* on file in the EXCEL/SSS Office;
- If two applicants are equally qualified and one is an Upward Bound or Educational Talent Search alumnus, preference will be given to the UB/ETS alumnus.
- *Previous recipients* of the EXCEL/SSS Scholarship are *not eligible to apply again*.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: \$500.00 (one-time award; non-renewable)

SELECTION PROCESS: EXCEL/SSS Office staff will review all applications for compliance with the eligibility requirements stated above. *Those applications which are complete* (i.e., include the completed application, a letter of recommendation from an instructor, and a 1 page typewritten essay outlining educational goals) *and which meet the eligibility requirements* will be sent to the Financial Aid Office. The Director of Financial Aid and/or the Financial Aid Committee will make the final selection.

APPLICATIONS: Applications for this scholarship may be obtained in the EXCEL/SSS Office. A letter of recommendation from an instructor as well as a one-page essay outlining your educational goals is required. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*

DEADLINE: *February 8th, 2010.* Submit completed applications to the EXCEL/SSS Office.
