**Admissions Requirements** — Everyone must apply to Mineral Area College and complete the Admissions process. It is the applicant's responsibility to have official high school and other college transcripts sent from the educational institution to the Admission Department by following the steps on the MAC website.

## **Emergency Medical Technician**

- You must have one of the following:
  - A minimum reading score of 18 on the ACT or 250 on Accuplacer Next Generation reading or
  - A minimum reading score of 16 on ACT <u>or</u> 240 on Accuplacer Next Generation reading <u>AND</u> a 2.8 cumulative high school GPA <u>or</u>
  - o A minimum grade of C in RDG0900, ENG0090 or ENG0990 or concurrent enrollment in RDG 0900 or
  - o Have earned 24 college-level semester credit hours
- Students must be eighteen (18) years of age by completion of the program

## Paramedic Certificate / Associate of Applied Science - Paramedic Technology

- Academic Test Scores All paramedic applicants must complete academic testing according to the following minimum scores. The Accuplacer Next Generation testing information, practice testing, and scheduling can be accessed online at www.mineralarea.edu or by calling the Assessment office at (573) 518-2202.
  - o Accuplacer Next Generation: Writing 250, Math 250, Reading 250
- Application Students who meet the entrance requirements must complete and submit a Paramedic Technology
  Program application. Applications can be found on MAC's website or from the office of EMS Education Programs.
- Deadlines All academic testing and prerequisite courses must be completed by the paramedic application deadline.
  Also, it is the applicant's responsibility to request official transcripts from other educational institutions prior to the application deadline.
- Personal Interview Once eligibility is established, paramedic applicants will be required to participate in a panel interview, which will be scored. The personal interview score will constitute 25% of the selection score.
- Contingent Acceptance Paramedic applicants who are selected into the paramedic program will be contingent upon meeting the following additional requirements as instructed in future correspondence following selection:
  - Residency & Identification Documents (DL, SS, BC, and/or Passport)
  - 2. Required Immunization Records

- 3. Current EMT License
- 4. Current CPR Certification
- 5. Drug Screen & Background Check
