INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

MAC is requesting qualifications from firms to provide a full range of services as Construction Manager at-Risk (CMaR) during the planning, design, and construction phases of multiple projects. The projects are currently intended to include the following:

A) Law Enforcement Academy. Approximately 12,000 square feet, new construction meant to house law enforcement training. Other construction components include but are not limited to, site development and grading, utility infrastructure, pavements, interior buildout and finishes, and mechanical/electrical/plumbing systems.

Academic Hall Renovations

Faculty West Office renovation (new store front to entrance, replace flooring HVAC updates)

Science Lab Updates (hood ventilation improvements, emergency shower plumbing, lighting control updates)

Health Professionals C11/12 classroom

AH small office removal and floor repair

AH 114 flooring (possible asbestos abatement), gas lines removed (former science lab)

Rice Lecture Hall renovation

Provost Suite relocation to Faculty East office area

Athletic Facilities

Restroom added to softball facility and renovated at baseball facility

New soccer/cross country/golf facility (locker rooms, showers, coaches offices)

MAC Tech

Welding expansion and ventilation (small addition to metal building for storage and shop space)

Fine Arts

Theater box office and concessions area (using existing space in old board room)
Art Studio and gallery (using existing empty offices)

The first project will be the construction of the Law Enforcement Academy and may include other projects from the list above. MAC may also elect to undertake the other projects in subsequent phases and to modify the list above to remove or add other campus improvements generally. MAC reserves the right to determine which, if any additional projects will be assigned to the selected CMaR and further reserves the right to select multiple CmaR's for different projects. MAC has retained a design firm and their consultant team to provide architectural and engineering related services, and the CMaR will be required to work with MAC and design team during the planning phase, construction documentation phases, and the construction process.

The current budget for the Work is estimated at approximately \$13 million dollars. Of that amount, MAC estimates approximately \$5.5 million will be allocated to the Law Enforcement Academy. The budgeted amounts may change over time.

This Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is the first step in a two-step competitive process by which MAC will engage a CMaR firm to provide Construction Management services. Step one will consist of a request for qualifications, review of those qualifications, and selection of a short list of firms who will proceed to step two. Respondents are not to include any information related to fees, costs, or price information in response to the RFQ. Step two will consist of the following, a short list of at least two but no more than five will be requested to respond to an RFP to be provided to them by MAC. The RFP will require the respondents to provide fees, costs and price information. MAC may also decide to interview respondents on the short list: The process for selection of a CMaR will be conducted in accordance with RSMo §67.5050. MAC reserves the right to reject any and/or all responses, to waive any informality or irregularity and/or any technical defect(s) in any response, and to select the response deemed by MAC to be the most advantageous to MAC.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The selected firm shall provide construction manager at-risk services as outlined in the AIA A133-2009 agreement between Owner and

CMAR, as modified.

SUBMITTING A RESPONSE

In submitting qualifications, the Respondent agrees to provide the services in accordance with the project scope. The response shall follow the outline provided and be concise. Failure to follow instruction may nullify response from consideration. To be considered for selection, Respondents should clearly limit responses to the specific criteria requested. No joint responses will be accepted by MAC.

The Deadline for submitting the response shall be in accordance with the notice. Submittals received after this date will not be considered. Telephone, facsimile, or electronic delivery of submittals will not be considered. MAC is not responsible for lateness or non-delivery by the United States Postal Service or other carriers to MAC. The time and date recorded by MAC shall be the official time of receipt. Submittals are to be prepared at no cost to MAC and will remain MAC's property.

Ownership of all data, materials, and documentation originated and prepared for MAC pursuant to the RFP shall belong exclusively to MAC and be subject to public inspection in accordance with the Missouri Sunshine Law.

Proposals will be evaluated to determine which firm best meets the needs of MAC.

Under no circumstances should your qualification submittal include any proposal of fees, costs, or prices.

REVIEW PROCESS

Following the deadline, the selection committee shall evaluate the qualifications. The period of evaluation of qualifications may be extended. Firms will be evaluated according to their response to the RFQ. A short list of respondents who will move to the second step will be compiled as described above.

CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS

Only after the submission of responses to RFP's and the selection of a CmaR(s) will MAC negotiate a contract for the services described in this RFQ solicitation with the selected firm(s.) If an agreement cannot be reached, there will be an attempt to negotiate a contract with the next selected firms(s). The process will continue until an agreement is reached.

FELONY CONVICTION NOTIFICATION

FEDERAL WORK AUTHORIZATION PROGRAM ("E-VERIFY") ADDENDUM

Pursuant to Missouri Revised Statute § 285.530, all business entities awarded any contract in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) with a Missouri political subdivision must, as a condition to the award of any such contract, be enrolled and participate in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services being provided, or to be provided, to the political subdivision (to the extent allowed by E-Verify). - e) Agrees to provide documentation of your participation in E-Verify to MAC prior to or contemporaneously with the execution of its contract with MAC (or at any time thereafter upon request by MAC), by providing to MAC an E-Verify screen print-out (or equivalent documentation) confirming your participation in E-Verify;
- f) Agrees to comply with any state of federal regulations or rules that may be issued subsequent to this addendum that relate to Missouri Revised Statute § 285.530, and
- g) Agrees that any failure by your company to abide by the requirements a) through f) above will be considered a material breach of your contract with MAC.
